Daniel Chidoti was born in 1980 in Mbera, an impoverished area of Harare. He still lives there with his wife Lucy and their daughter Betty. He is a self-taught artist and his work is made from recycled materials. He is a member of the Harare Art Society and has exhibited his work in several galleries. His inspiration for this may come from his father, who is an elder of the church.

Daniel learned to carve with the guidance of his brother Stanley who also works as a professional carver. Finding it difficult at first to make  
endure. Carving is still one of the few remaining respected ways in which to earn a living these days. Having had to learn to make a  
living for his abstracts and animal sculptures, Daniel work is very well polished and gracefully simplistic. His stone of preference is Black  
Serpentine.
